Follow up telephone calls by committee members to determine if the districts will be participating this year have been made. Their responses have been most enthusiastic.

Presenters are being secured, who are engaged in the fields of science, technology, engineering and math, and will do hands on activities with the girls related to their expertise. The speaker committee has been hard at work, and expect to secure the keynote and final speaker before February.

The registration forms with workshop titles will be delivered to the individual schools in late February, with the responses due back to the committee around Easter.
